- Please respect your neighbour's garden & only take vegetables from your own plot.

The Auckland Teaching Gardens is a Charitable Trust, so we do ask for a contribution of \$30 inc GST per season. You **MUST** attend the gardens at least one of the two official working days for your particular gardens. This will ensure the Mentor can remain in contact with you.
